

Fall Festival & Car Show Rules & Regulations

CAR SHOW RULES & VEHICLE ETIQUETTE

- **Vehicle Safety:** Strictly zero tolerance for burnouts, engine revving, tire spinning, or speeding on or near the event grounds. Display vehicles must remain parked until directed by parking marshals.
- **Parking Instructions:** Follow all parking marshal directions upon entry. Blocking aisles or emergency lanes is strictly prohibited.
- **Spectator Etiquette:** Respect vehicle owners—do not touch, lean on, or open any vehicle without explicit permission.
- **Audio Levels:** Keep personal stereos at a moderate volume so official announcements remain clear.

VENDOR & FACILITY GUIDELINES

- **Booth Requirements:** Vendor spaces are 10'x10'. Setup must be complete by 9:30 AM. No electricity, tables, or chairs are provided.
- **Grounds Rules:** Open flames, charcoal grills, and personal cooking equipment are prohibited near display vehicles. All pets must remain leashed, and owners must clean up after them.
- **ADA Accessibility:** Emergency access lanes and designated handicap parking aisles must remain completely unobstructed by display vehicles, tents, or equipment.

LEGAL DISCLAIMERS & COMPLIANCE

- **Alabama Sales Tax:** Vendors are solely responsible for collecting, reporting, and remitting all applicable Alabama State and Clay County sales taxes on physical sales.
- **Food Safety Permits:** Food vendors must maintain and visibly display a valid temporary food permit from the Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH).
- **Liability & Hold Harmless:** By registering or attending, all vendors, vehicle owners, and participants agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Mellow Valley Community Center, event organizers, and volunteers from any liability regarding vehicle damage, personal injury, theft, or loss incurred during the event.
